



On April 22nd, 23rd and 24th 2005, TinBenders.Org in association with Pirate4x4.com and CalRocs will be hosting the 2005 Toyota Jamboree at the Johnson Valley, California OHV area (aka The Hammers). All profits earned through registrations, donations, truck raffle, or sponsorships will be donated to the Friends of Panamint Valley. The Tin Benders are committed to hosting a family oriented wheeling event that will test the skills of the driver, abilities of their rig and their propensity for fun.

Registration

The event will have a \$35.00 registration fee (\$25 event fee plus \$10 BLM surcharge) Onsite registration may be limited and will cost \$45. These fees will cover Permits, Insurance, Waste Facilities, Two organized trail runs, Raffle and (1) Dinner on Saturday. Dinners for registered passengers will be available for a nominal fee.

The Hosts

TinBenders.Org is a non-profit corporation that was formed with the expressed purpose of allowing us to host events of this caliber. The Tin Benders are a nationally known 4 Wheel Drive Club based in Southern California that calls the Hammers home. We have received multiple Citations of Merit from the Bureau of Land Management for our efforts to maintain our Public Lands and are committed to educate wheelers the importance of trail management.

The Cause

The Tin Benders have chosen to support the Friends of Panamint Valley, a non-profit organization that is devoted to the effort to re-open Surprise Canyon as well as maintain and protect the entire Panamint Region.

The Event

Friday, April 22nd, the event will kick-off with and on-site truck buildup during the day and organized night runs on the various Hammer Trails. Saturday morning will feature 11 trail runs led throughout the JV OHV area. Each trail will list requirements for participation (i.e. Lockers, 35" Tires, etc). Each trail leader will ensure that their group returns to camp. The event will conclude with a dinner and raffle along with a presentation thanking our sponsors.
